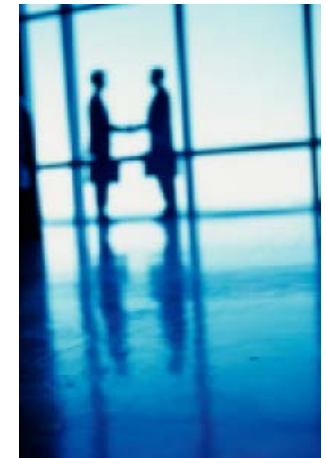

Why you should donate

Important disclaimers

- Contributions will be used in connection with a federal election
- Super PACs are required to make "best efforts" to obtain, maintain, and report name, address, occupation, and employer of whoever donates more than \$200 in a calendar year. In order to show "best efforts," solicitations must specifically request that information and inform contributors that the committee is required by law to undertake best efforts to report it.
- There is no maximum contribution limit, and donations can be accepted from individuals, corporations, and other organizations.
- Super PACs are not allowed to accept foreign donations, but other nonprofit organizations may choose to. Please send all foreign donations to MOESES, which will be earmarked for

education expenditures only. Contribution information to MOESES will not be released to the public.

In an effort to reduce the amount of paperwork, I kindly ask one of two things if you intend to make a contribution:

1. Donate less than \$200 to RAD directly
2. Donate to MOESES, a nonprofit 501(c)(4) social welfare organization that will funnel the funds to RAD
